EXPLANATION

A **USGA Course Rating** is the USGA's evaluation of the playing difficulty of a course for scratch golfers under normal course and weather conditions for the purpose of providing a uniform basis on which to issue **USGA Handicap Index**. It is expressed as strokes taken to one decimal place, and is based on yardage and other obstacles to the extent that they affect the scoring ability of a scratch golfer.

A **USGA Short Course Rating** is the evaluation of the playing difficulty of a Short Course for scratch players under normal course and weather conditions for the purpose of providing a uniform basis on which to issue **USGA Short Course Handicaps**. A Short Course is defined as any 18-hole golf course that is less than 3,000 yards in length.

A **USGA Slope Rating** evaluates the relative playing difficulty of a course for players who are not scratch golfers. The lowest USGA Slope Rating is 55 and the highest is 155. A golf course of standard playing difficulty has a USGA Slope Rating of 113.

Course Ratings are determined, by permission of the United States Golf Association, in accordance with the USGA Course Rating System. **USGA Course Ratings, Slope** and **Handicap Index** are service marks owned by the USGA and may only be used in connection with the USGA Handicap System.
